TEZPUR COLLEGE - A PROFILE

Tezpur College, one of the premier colleges of Assam, came in to existence in the year 1965 due to untiring efforts of Late Dulal Chandra Bhattacharjee, a doyen of teaching and legal community of Assam. He was also the founder president of the college. Started as an evening college for the benefit of poor students and housed in Tezpur Academy, the College was later shifted to the present site on the flank of the famous picturesque hillock of Agnigarh in 1968.

Late P. Prasad, a senior High Court advocate, was the first honorary principal of this college. Sri Heramba Sarmah senior Advocate of Tezpur Bar and Late jogendra Chandra Bhattacharjee, also senior Advocate of Tezpur Bar, contributed a lot for the growth of this college. During the years 1967-1994, the college enjoyed the guidance and perseverance of Late C.M. Medhi, who steered the college through its infancy and laid the foundation for its present pre-eminence and all round development. Late C.M. Medhi, retired on 31.3.94 after his distinguished service of long twenty-seven years. Mrs. A. Borah, Vice Principal of the College succeeded him as Principal i/c from 1.4.94 to 28.2.98.

After the retirement of Mrs. A. Borah, Prof. S.K. Padmapati was the Principal i/c of the College from 1-3-98 to 10-4-98, Prof. J.N. Choudhury has joined as the Principal of the college on 11-4-98. During his tenure the College was assessed and accredited by NAAC. After his retirement, Dr. Charu Saharia Nath is the Principal of this College, who has joined on 9-9-04 as its regular Principal with an aim to devote herself for the overall development of the College, keeping pace with the present academic scenario of the whole Country maintaining its glory of the past with the goodwill and cooperation of one and all.

Introduction of different career oriented courses, establishment of the contact centre of the IDOL, GU and study centre of KKHSOU is the result of her untiring effort. Apart from these the introduction of Commerce faculty, BBA and BMC Course is considered as another milestone in the academic sphere of the college. As a result the college was reaccredited with 'B' Grade on the 8th January 2011.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

COURSES OF STUDY :

1. The College offers Higher Secondary (10+2) and Degree courses (1+1+1) of study in Arts, Commerce and Business management faculties. In the degree level facilities are provided to students to pursue major in Assamese, English, Economics, Education, History, Political Science, Philosophy, Bengali, Geography, Management and Accounting.
A student can offer Elective Assamese as elective subject in the degree level provided he or she does not offer Major in Assamese.
2. In the Higher Secondary class, the college provides the following subjects English, Alt. English, Assamese, Bengali, History, Political Science, Economics, Education, Logic & Philosophy, Geography, Advance Assamese and Advance Bengali.

Combination of Subjects (B.A. Classes)

- a. English & M.I.L. are compulsory for all.
- b. Alt. English can be taken up instead of M.I.L.
Besides these, the students shall choose any two of the following subjects:
Economics, Education, History, Political Science, Philosophy, Elective Assamese, Geography, Elective Bengali, Travel and Tourism Management. (Vocational) Students offering major will take only one general subject along with the Major subject. The Head of the Department concerned selects students for Major courses in order of merit. No provision of Major in **2nd shift** in any subject.

Note : The admission Committee's decision on combination of subjects is final and binding.

 (5) There is provision for repeat of any one of theory papers in 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th Semester, and may be allowed for “Bettermen” of marks in one paper in 5th semester provided the student secures less than 45% of marks in that paper.

In the six semester there must be atleast one paper where the students are given opportunity to apply their knowledge. The Course may be designed that students' creativity is encouraged. This could be a small academic project, an advanced level practical work, literary survey on a topic, field/survey work or any other work which may induce creativity among the child.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

1. Summer Vacation : 16th June / 2011 to 15th July / 2011.
2. Admission shall be done once in a year and admission to 1st semester TDC classes be completed by 15th June/2011.
3. The classes of 1st semester be commenced from 16th July / 2011
4. Annual College week be held in the last week of January 2012 / first week of February 2012.
5. Students Union Election of the College is to be held within 15th September / 2011.
6. Sessional Exam (for 1st semester) be completed by first half of September / 2011
7. End Semester Exam (for first semester) be completed by 31st December / 2011
8. Declaration of end Semester (for first Semester) examination results be given by 15th March / 2012
9. Commencement of 2nd Semester class be from first week of January / 2012. (i.e. without waiting for the declaration of results).

COURSE STRUCTURE HIGHER SECONDARY (ARTS)

- a. English & M.I.L. compulsory for all.
- b. Alt. English can be taken up instead of M.I.L.
- c. A student shall select any three of the following as core subjects and any one as additional (4th) subject.
Economics, Education, History, Political Science, Geography, Logic & Philosophy, Advance Assamese, Advance Bengali.

Course Structure : (H.S. Classes) : Each subject shall be of 100 marks for 1st year course and second year course. In 2nd year there shall be one theory paper of 70 marks and one practical paper of 30 marks for science subject.

BBA COURSE

The three year degree course in BBA of Guahati University has been started from the session 2009-2010, for which regular classes are held in the college. An Information Brochure will be supplied alongwith this Prospectus for details regarding Course structure, admission schedule etc.

BMC COURSE

The college is going to start the three year degree course in Bachelor of Mass Communication of Gauhati University from this session. The details of course structure, fee structure and admission schedule shall be notified in due time.

SUBJECT COMBINATION (for degree classes)

1. English, M.I.L. / Alt. English Compulsory.
2. Arts - Any two electives from the subject: Pol.Science., Education, History, Economics, Geography, Philosophy, Adv/Elective Assamese, Adv./Elective Bengali, TTM.
3. Commerce- Any four electives for general course and any five electives for Major course from :- BMS, FIN, Finacial, Accounting, BED, IFS, CAC, HRM for degree course.
4. Combination not allowed- Education, Philosophy, Adv. or elective languages with Geography and TTM.

COURSE STRUCTURE **FOR H.S. (Com) CLASSES.**

- a. English and MIL compulsory for all.
- b. Alt. English can be taken up instead of MIL.
- c. Compulsory Subjects (Elective subjects):-
 - i) Business Studies - 100 marks.
 - ii) Accountancy - 100 marks.
- d. Third and Fourth Elective subjects (any two form the following)
 - i) Economics (ii) banking (iii) Economic Geography
 - (iv) Insurance (v) Enterepreneurship Development (vi) CAES
 - (vii) Mathematics (All are of 100 marks each)

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

The new session starts with the opening of the College after the summer vacation. The application forms for admission to the College should be obtained and submitted along with all necessary particulars within the prescribed date as notified by the college. Forms and prospectus are available in the college office on payment. Students are selected for admission strictly on merits. There should not be any pressure from any quarter directly or indirectly for admitting a particular student. If such pressure is exercised, the concerned students shall forfeit his/her claim. However, there will be a few seats under reservation for reserved catagories as per govt. rules. In case of the reserved seats also, the same procedure of merit will be followed.

The students are required to produce the following at the time of interview in original.

- a. The relevant mark sheets.
- b. The certificate from the head of the Institution last attended.
- c. Migration certificate in case of student migrating from other Board and Universities.
- d. Affidavit for break of study or gap period certificate from competent authority.
- e. One copy of passport size photograph.
- f. Selected students shall have to get themselves admitted on the day of interview, failing which their seats shall be forfeited.
- g. No applicant can claim for a seat, only on the ground that he/she has passed earlier examination from this college.

FACILITIES PROVIDED BY THE COLLEGE

1. **The Library :**

The Chandra Mohan Medhi Library of the college is a well-equipped library with an audio-visual section along with a spacious reading room.

Library Opening hours :

Weekdays : 9 AM to 4 PM

Saturdays : 9 AM to 2 PM

Issue Time : 11AM to 2 PM

(According to the days for different classes notified by the Librarian) However the reading room may be utilized from 8 AM.

Penalty : Students are not allowed to keep the library books more than 15 days. If a student fails to return a book in time he/she will be liable for a penalty. Books lost, defaced or injured in any form shall have to be replaced by the borrower.

2. **Students' Union :**

There is a students' body in the name of Tezpur College Students' Union to look after the interest of the students. The Executive members of the Union are annually elected by the students through direct election.

3. **Students' Aid Fund :**

A fund is created with contribution from each student of the college to provide financial assistance to poor and deserving students.

4. **Students' Travelling Concession :**

Students of the college are entitled for Railway concession whenever they travel to their home and back to the college or vice versa.

5. **College and Wall Magazine :**

College Magazine and Wall magazine aim at reflecting the various facts of life in the college. These are both scholarly and slightherted and offer an opening for literary, editorial and artistic talent besides being memento of the year spent here.

6. **Departmental Association :**

Another fact of academic life in this college is provided by the Departmental Associations. Their attempt is to take the discipline beyond the confines of the college syllabi, by raising and analysing issues marginalized by the mainstream through lectures, discussions, special survey etc.

7. **Scouts and Guide :**

The Scout and Guide is an organization, which provides an opportunity for students to develop leadership qualities, self confidence as a disciplined and devoted citizen of the country.

8. **NSS Unit :**

There is an N.S.S. Unit in the college, which organizes a number of activities including campus in rural areas, which exposes the students to social service.

9. Awards and Prizes :

The Teachers' Unit of the college have instituted a fund to award prizes to the students of the college who stand first at the final examinations of H.S. and T.D.C. amongst the candidates of the college. Best reader award is offered to the college library user. The college organises Inter College C.M. Medhi memorial debate competition in every year.

10. Career Guidance Cell :

A career Guidance Cell is run by the college to guide the students for developing their career counseling programmes.

11. Grievance Redressal Cell :

There is a Grievance Redressal Cell specially for students.

12. Centre for Extension Education :

Activities for Extension Education have been conducted at the different times.

13. Computer Education Centre :

Tezpur College Computer Education Centre is conducting the following Computer Education Programmes for the students :

1. Computer for beginners - 1 month.
2. MS Word, MS Excel - 3 months.
3. Internet - 1 month.

14. Self Financing Courses :

The college authority is offering the following Self Financing Courses:

- a) **Art and Music** : Affiliated to Sarbabharatiya Sanskriti Parisad- Kolkata B.Music/M.Music.
- b) **Functional English** (Assisted by U.G.C. for certificate Diploma and Adv. Diploma course.)
- c) **Forestry and Wild life management** (Assisted by U.G.C. for Certificate Diploma and Adv.Diploma course.)
- d) **Tourism and Travel Management** : Six months Diploma course in Tourism and Travel Management assisted by UGC is introduced in 2007.

15. N.C.C. :

A wing of National cadet Corps Girls has been already opened. Boys wing is going to be established in 2009.

16. Planning Forum :

There is a Planning Forum in the college for its related activities.

17. Research Promotion Cell :

The Research Promotion Cell of the College has been established with an aim to aid and boost the research activities in the college.

18. Gymnasium and Health Club :

The College encourages and promotes talented students in the field of sports and arts through its modern gymnasiums and health club.

19. Remedial Classes :

The College is also permitted by the UGC to introduce Remedial Classes for S.C., S.T. and minority students.

20. Women's Studies Cell :

The college has also established an Women's Studies Cell to Promote the differential activities relating to the women's education.

21. College Canteen :

The college has a canteen within the campus for refreshment of the students and teachers, The canteen remains open from 9 A.M. to 5 P.M. in working days.

22. Common Rooms :

There are separate Common Rooms for boys and girls with necessary facilities.

23. Students' Union Office :

There is a office of Students' Union of the college attached to Boys' Common Room.

24. Alumni Association :

The Alumni Association of the College is formed with its ex-students and a office is provided within the campus for its day to day activities.

25. IQAC :

The college maintains an Internal Quality Assurance cell for its alround development, which regularly assesses the students teachers and employees.

26. 'Sahitya Chora' organises various literary programmes both for the students and teachers.

27. Internet facility is available for the students and teachers in the computer section of the college for nominal payment.

COLLEGE UNIFORM

It is strictly compulsory for every students to come to the college with full uniform.

For Boys : White Shirt and Black Pant. (Navy Blue Sweater in Winter)

For Girls : Sky Blue Blouse, Muga Mekhela with Sky Blue bordered Chadar. (Navy Blue Sweater in Winter) or Sky Blue Churider Kurta with white Pyajama and white Dupatta. (Navy Blue Sweater in Winter.)

Institute of Distance and open learning (IDOL, GU)

A contact centre of Gauhati University named Post Graduate Correspondence School has been established from July 05 which is renamed as Institute of Distance and Open Learning by Gauhati University in its Academic council meeting on April, 2008. The centre is for correspondance P.G. Degree courses of Gauhati University in Assamese, English, History, Political Science, Economics, Mathematics and P.G. Diploma courses in Sales and Marketing Management (P.G.D.S.M.), Human Resource Management (P.G.D.H.R.M.) Business Management (P.G.D.B.M.) and computer Aplication (P.G.D.C.A.).

K.K. HANDIQUE STATE OPEN UNIVERSITY (STUDY CENTRE)

K.K. Handique State Open University study centre was established in Tezpur College in 2008. K.K. Handique State Open University is a State University established under an act of Assam Government in 2007 to provide access to higher education (now upto Graduation level) for the drop out students or the students who could not continue their studies upto Graduation level due to certain reasons. The study centre provides opportunities to the students who could not appear. H.S.L.C. or H.S.S.L.C. examination to quality for it is Bechelors Preparatory

12. The following activities of the students in the college will be treated as serious offence. All powers for maintaining discipline are vested with the Principal and the disciplinary action committee and their decision shall be final in all such matters like -
 - i. Encouraging and participation in ragging of any type.
 - ii. Forcible disruption of classes.
 - iii. Destructions of college properties like furniture, wall, fencings etc.
 - iv. Misbehaviour shown towards fellow friends, teachers and employees of the college.
 - v. Forwarding any type of wrong information to the college authority.
13. Every student must actively and positively participate in maintaining cleanliness of the campus of the college. The students must avoid any act, which may make the campus unclean.
14. Students who bring vehicles, such as cycles, scooters etc. must park them at the student's parking stand only.
The students are expressly prohibited from parking their vehicles at any other place.
15. Smoking and consumption of tobacco, alcohol, gutkha or any other intoxicants within the college premises is strictly prohibited.
16. Use of Mobile Phone inside the campus is strictly prohibited.
17. Entering inside the college campus without uniform is strictly prohibited.

SPECIAL FEATURES

1. Provision for merit scholarship for brilliant students.
2. Names of the brilliant students will be recommended for financial assistance, scholarships to different organization and institutions.
3. Free Computer Education to all First Divisioner of HSLC and HS examinations.
4. Financial Assistance and facilities for eminent sports persons/artist to participate in the national and state level competitions.
5. Free coaching classes and study materials for S.C./S.T. and minority students under Remedial course.
Facilities for adventure sports like Trekking, Mountaineering, Rafting, Angling para cycling etc.

HOSTEL

The girls' hostel of the college is situated within the campus. At present the girls' hostel can accomodate 32 students. Boarders are provided with modern amenities like 4 hours running water, T.V., indoor and outdoor games facilities, news papers etc. Admission into the hostel is on merit basis, seats for reserved catagories are allotted as per Govt. norms.

HOSTEL RULES

1. The boarders must maintain a decent , dignified and disciplined hostel lifestyle inside and outside the hostel.
2. They must abide by the rules and regulations of the hostel as may be prescribed to them by the College Authority, violation of which will invite strict disciplinary action amounting to expulsion of the guilty inmate from the hostel leading also to consequent expulsion from the College.
3. Boarders must enter into the hostel within the time fixed by the superintendent / warden for summer and winter season and must be present at their respective seat at the time of Roll-Call.

4. Entertainment of guests and visitors is not allowed except with prior permission of the authority.
5. Visitors other than Legal/Local guardians are not allowed to meet the inmates of the hostel without the permission of the Principal.
6. Boarders must have to pay their Mess-Dues as may be fixed from month to month by the mess- committee within the 10th day of every month.
7. Ill-treatment to co-boarders, cooks and other employees of the hostel is strictly prohibited.
8. The use of electrical equipment such as iron, heater etc. is not permitted.
9. The boarders must attend their classes regularly and must appear in all internal examinations and other academic activities of the departments of the College.
10. Disturbance of any kind during study hours is treated as serious offence.
11. All the boarders must abide by the Mess-Rules prescribed by the Mess-Committee.
12. Ragging is Strictly Prohibited.
